About cookies

Our website uses cookies. Cookies are text files with small pieces of data that are used to identify your browser or the device you use to access our website.

How we use cookies

Some of the cookies we use are essential (our website won't work without them), and others make our website work more efficiently and help us to recognise when you return to our website.

Essential cookies

Cookies required for the operations of our website.

Preference cookies

- Cookies we use to recognise when you return to our website. This allows us to personalise our content to suit you, and you can save your preferences on your device (such as the remember me on this computer etc.)
- We suggest you don't ask your browser to save any cookie preferences on public devices (such as a library computer), and only on your own devices for security purposes.

Analytical cookies

- These cookies allow us to collect data about visitors to our website. The cookies count
 the number of visitors and allows us to see how visitors are engaging with our website
 (for example, it's important to us that website users are finding the website easy to
 navigate and use, and make changes to improve its usability).
- Information collected for these purposes (and shared with cookie providers) remains anonymous or is collected in a way that users of our website cannot be identified for this data.
